The Famous 34th Infantry Division!

The 34th Infantry Division was named and organized from existing regiments and units of the Iowa, Minnesota and Nebraska NG in 1917, during WWI at Camp Cody, NM. After mobilization, the 168th Inf and 151 FA served together in the great war with the 42nd "Rainbow Division" while the remainder of the 34th Infantry Division served on Mexican border duty and later arrived to fight in France in September 1918.

The 34th Division, in World War II, has the distinction of being the First U.S. Division to land in the European Theatre and also had more days in combat (over 600) than any other. It is accredited with capturing more than 40,000 enemy soldiers.

Twenty men assigned to the 34th ID and attached units were Awarded the Medal of Honor.

The 34th Infantry Division has had all individual units, battalions and brigades federalized to serve in the continental U.S., Iraq and Afghanistan during the War On Terror from 2001- 2016.

We continue to support today's soldiers serving in the 34th Infantry Division, and all other U.S. Army organizations who are protecting our American Way of Life.
