Dear Veteran of the 34th (Red Bull) Division:

Three years ago we published the first Official Roster of the 34th Infantry Division Association. The time has come to replace that roster with an up-to-date one, for in that period of time there have been many changes.

As we did in 1955, we are mailing this roster to every one we have on our mailing list, in the hope that it will provide you with the address of a buddy. If you like it, will you send us a dollar.

We have made every effort to include every name and address available to us, that we are reasonably sure is correct. No doubt there are some errors, and we will appreciate your putting us straight. You will find at the back of the book a few names inadvertently omitted, or received after the process of publication had started.

The 34th Infantry Division Association was organized 12 July 1946, in the City of Des Moines, Iowa, and incorporated under the provisions of the Code of Iowa.

This Association was formed to foster and perpetuate the camaraderie of brothers-in-arms of those who have served with the 34th Infantry Division since its organization.

Article IX of the Articles of Incorporation provides that there shall be an annual reunion on the week-end following the first Monday in September of each year. The selection of the reunion city is determined by vote of members in session at the annual reunion.

Article III of the By-laws provides for the organization of Chapters of the Association. A Chapter may be organized, and the Board of Trustees will grant a charter, provided the petition for charter is signed by no less than fifteen (15) persons who qualify for membership as prescribed in the Articles of Incorporation of the Association. Membership in the 34th Infantry Division Association is restricted to those persons who were members of any unit or organization which was an organic part of the 34th Infantry Division at any time during the period 15 July 1917--6 Dec. 1941, plus those persons who were members of any unit or organization assigned or attached to the 34th Infantry Division during the period 7 Dec. 1941--

1 Nov 1945, plus those veterans of WW II who have been members of the 34th Infantry Division National Guard for three or more years since 19 Nov. 1946.

The annual membership fee is \$2.00, payable to the Secretary 34th Infantry Division Association, Red Horse Armory, Des Moines 10, Iowa. The membership year starts 1 Sep and ends 31 Aug the following year.


The first Association meeting was held in Des Moines, Iowa, in 1946, with Norman E. Hendrickson, former chief of staff, serving as first president.
