34th Div Soldiers Decorated

In recent action soldiers of the 100th Infantry Battalion and 442d Regimental Combat Team with Distinguished Service Crosses were upgraded to the Congressional Medal of Honor. Eleven of these soldiers were assigned to the 34th Division in ITALY when they received the recommendation for award. They are:

This places the 34th Infantry Division AT THE TOP, or close to the top, of the Medals of Honor in World War II, a total of 22 RED BULLS.

The ceremonies were held in Washington D.C., at the Arlington National Cemetery, at the Pentagon Court Yard the Hall of Honor, and at the Washington Hilton Hotel. The ceremonies were most impressive and were attended by the families of those gallant RED BULLS that were honored.
